We are pleased to invite you to the 19th International Conference on Economic Convergence in European Union, "Paradigm shifts towards the green economy" which will take place online between 7-8th of April 2022.

Organized by **The Faculty of Theoretical and Applied Economics**, *the ECEU conference is a multidisciplinary forum that promotes interaction and knowledge exchange among scholars from diverse research fields*.

This year the main topic of the conference revolves around potential economic, social, or technological shifts caused by the transition to green economy. The zero-carbon emissions agenda emerges as a vital target that the world economy needs to reach, but, at the same time, some short- and medium-term economic disruptions might seem ineluctable. In addition, the current anxiety caused by the surge of energy prices prompts a closer relationship between the standard of living and limited resources reminding us of conveniently forgotten times of shortages and restrictive consumption. Present circumstances provide solid arguments that, while the renewable resources are not yet reliable and available on a wider scale, the energy market further relies on fossil fuels, prone to environmental disruptions and sensitive to geopolitical frictions. Against this background, the need for significant shifts in public policies and constant investments in renewable resources become ever more urgent. For instance, policymakers should be concerned with redesigning energy markets in terms of organizing an efficient storing process that might alleviate potential energy crises. In this context, the main goal of the 19th International Conference on Economic Convergence in the European Union is to provide a platform for research and discussions on topics that are centered on the potential paradigm shifts caused by the transition towards the green economy.

Participants will submit the abstract via email to <u>simpozioneconomie@economie.ase.ro</u> no later than 3rd of March 2022.

Full papers as well as short papers (abstracts or drafts of research in progress you would like to share) are accepted.

Submitted papers will be peer reviewed in terms of novelty, originality, relevance, scientific soundness, methodological design, results, and contribution. It is **ECEU** policy to make efforts to send complete papers to two reviewers for full blind peer review. Submitted papers must not have been previously published or currently submitted for publication elsewhere.

Selected papers will be published in a Special issue of Theoretical and Applied Economics Journal, indexed in EconLit, RePec, DOAJ, EBSCO and ICAAP.
